# WHAT IS EASTER?



Easter is the time of the year when Christians all around the world focus on the sacrificial work of Jesus Christ on the Cross - when He became sin for us, shed his blood for us, died for us and rose again on the third day for us.

*"For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures; and that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures." 1 Corinthians 15:3,4*

## **WHY DID JESUS CHRIST DIE ON THE CROSS?**

Jesus Christ died on the Cross for OUR sins, not His. Jesus never sinned once. But we all have sinned and so He went to the Cross out of His great love for US to sacrificially die for US so that the wages of sin, which is death, would be paid for US.

*"For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." Romans 3:23*

*"For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 6:23*

## **WHY DID JESUS CHRIST RISE FROM THE DEAD?**

Jesus Christ rose from the dead on the third day in order to provide ETERNAL LIFE for members of the entire human race who believe upon Him.

*"Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die." John 11:25,26*

## **WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO BELIEVE UPON JESUS CHRIST?**

To believe upon Jesus Christ does NOT mean to simply believe that He exists. To believe upon Jesus Christ DOES mean to trust Him ALONE as your personal Savior.

*"For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved." Romans 10:13*

*"For ye are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus." Galatians 3:26*

## **WHAT HAPPENS TO THOSE WHO BELIEVE UPON JESUS CHRIST?**

All who believe upon Jesus Christ will experience the forgiveness of their sins and will receive eternal life now which will be lived forever in Heaven in the presence of God.
